

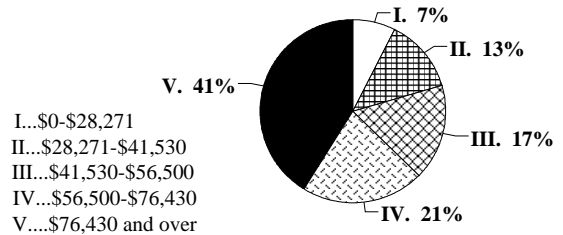

Richest fifth vs. middle fifth	47

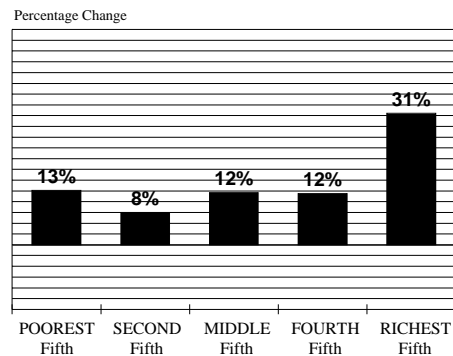
### Share of Income Held by Each Income Fifth, Late 1990s

Poorest Fifth . . .	\$2,040*	13%
Middle Fifth . . . .	\$5,290*	12%
Richest Fifth . . . .	\$29,430*	31%

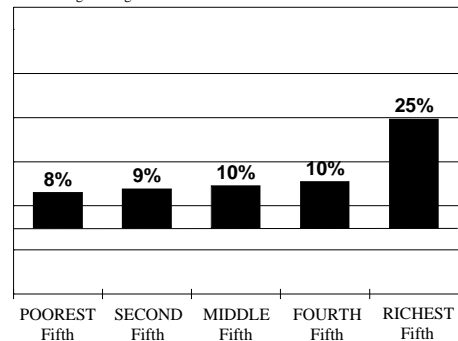
### Income Change for Utah Families Late 1970s to Late 1990s, by Fifth of Families



### Inflation-Adjusted Change in Incomes Late 1980s to Late 1990s

	Dollar Change	% Change
Poorest Fifth . . .	\$1,360*	8%
Middle Fifth . . . .	\$4,270*	10%
Richest Fifth . . . .	\$24,870*	25%
