

AND NOW, this 26th day of April, 2021, the Defendant having entered open Guilty Pleas to Theft/Failure to Make Required Disposition of Funds Received, five (5) counts, Misdemeanors of the First Degree; he being fully and competently represented by counsel and the Court being satisfied that he has knowingly, voluntarily and intelligently entered said Pleas, it is the SENTENCE of this Court that on the Offense of Theft/Failure to Make Required Disposition of Funds Received, count 1, the Defendant pay a fine of Seven Hundred Fifty (\$750.00) Dollars, plus costs of prosecution; that he be incarcerated in the Clearfield County Jail for a term the minimum of which shall be thirty (30) days and the maximum of which shall be six (6) months less one (1) day, to be initiated by reporting to said jail by no later than 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 18, 2021; while incarcerated, the Defendant shall strictly comply with all job tasks and responsibilities assigned to him by officials of the Clearfield County Jail; upon parole, he shall attend

and successfully complete any such counseling and/or treatment as may be recommended by his supervising Parole/Probation Officer and be responsible for all costs associated therewith; the Defendant shall submit to DNA testing and pay costs in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars; he shall successfully complete two hundred (200) hours of community service under the standard terms and conditions of the Clearfield County Community Service Program or under the standard terms and conditions of the community service program in effect in Centre County, Pennsylvania, his county of residence.

On the Offense of Theft/Failure to Make Required Disposition of Funds Received, count 2, that the Defendant pay a fine of Seven Hundred Fifty (\$750.00) Dollars, plus costs of prosecution; that he be incarcerated in the Clearfield County Jail for a term the minimum of which shall be thirty (30) days and the maximum of which shall be six (6) months less one (1) day, to be served consecutive to the sentence as set forth above for Theft/Failure to Make Required Disposition of Funds Received, count 1, and under the same terms and conditions as set forth therein.

On the Offense of Theft/Failure to Make Required Disposition of Funds Received, count 3, that the Defendant pay a fine of Seven Hundred Fifty (\$750.00) Dollars, plus costs of prosecution; that he be incarcerated in the

Clearfield County Jail for a term the minimum of which shall be thirty (30) days and the maximum of which shall be six (6) months less one (1) day, to be served consecutive to the sentence as set forth above for Theft/Failure to Make Required Disposition of Funds Received, count 2, and under the same terms and conditions as set forth therein.

On the Offense of Theft/Failure to Make Required Disposition of Funds Received, count 4, that the Defendant pay a fine of Seven Hundred Fifty (\$750.00) Dollars, plus costs of prosecution; that he be incarcerated in the Clearfield County Jail for a term the minimum of which shall be thirty (30) days and the maximum of which shall be six (6) months less one (1) day, to be served consecutive to the sentence as set forth above for Theft/Failure to Make Required Disposition of Funds Received, count 3, and under the same terms and conditions as set forth therein.

On the Offense of Theft/Failure to Make Required Disposition of Funds Received, count 5, that the Defendant pay a fine of Seven Hundred Fifty (\$750.00) Dollars, plus costs of prosecution; that he serve a period of probation of three (3) years under the supervision and control of the Clearfield County Department of Probation Services, Adult Division, to be served consecutive to the sentence as set forth above for Theft/Failure to Make Required Disposition of Funds Received, count 4, and under the same terms and

conditions as set forth therein.


The Court notes that any other counts contained within the Information not disposed of above are withdrawn upon sentencing.

The Defendant may be eligible to participate in this county's re-entry plan, which includes the work Release Program, Earned Time Credit Program, Intermediate Punishment Program and Early Release Program. The Court notes that all

participants must be approved by the Court prior to entering any program.

The Defendant is hereby placed on notice that during the term of incarceration at the Clearfield County Jail, the Defendant shall be subject to random and unannounced drug screening. If, after the first seven (7) days of incarceration, the Defendant tests positive for any illegal substance (except marijuana) or controlled substance for which the Defendant does not have a prescription, the positive result will be considered a violation of the terms of any probation to which the Defendant is subject. If, after the first thirty (30) days of incarceration, the Defendant tests positive for marijuana, the positive result will be considered a violation of the terms of any probation to which the Defendant is subject.
